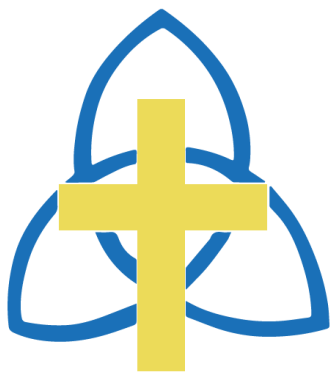

Dear Friends,

This morning I attended a 'Pastors of Edenvale' meeting. We gather regularly during the year to connect as pastors, to worship together, to pray for the church in Edenvale and to seek God on ways to partner together for God's Kingdom. It is an ongoing process of relationship building to foster unity and cooperation among the church in Edenvale and the pastors.

There have been some wonderful initiative over the years which have come about when working together as the church of Edenvale. One of those initiatives was the establishment of the Khanyisa Trust which serves the poor and hungry in our community. It has been going for approximately 35 years. More recently we have been gathering together for combined worship services on Resurrection Sunday, we held a "march for Jesus" last year, and a 'Unite the Vale' event which aimed to provide prayer and advice about life issues.

This morning, we talked about a wonderful initiative which is planned for the 24th of September 2025, Heritage Day. It is called "**The Street Store**". Here is the basic idea:

- To provide a dignified way for people who struggle to afford clothes and shoes to browse and choose an outfit (1 shirt/dress, 1 pair of pants/skirt, 1 pair of shoes and 1 jacket)
- A street store will be set up with clothes and shoes gathered through donations from the community.
- Volunteers will sort clothes into categories and sizes.
- Volunteers will assist each person in choosing a set of clothes and then checking out at the exit.
- Volunteers will assist with folding and presenting the clothes in a bag at the check out.
- Volunteers will assist with replenishing the clothes in the store as needed.
- Volunteers will assist with coordinating volunteers, the set up and the project process.

As you see, this is a significant initiative which requires many volunteers. I want to appeal to you if you would like to participate in this by volunteering in some way, please let me know and attend a planning meeting on the 17th or 18th of June (date to be confirmed).

May verse - “Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.” Exodus 20:12

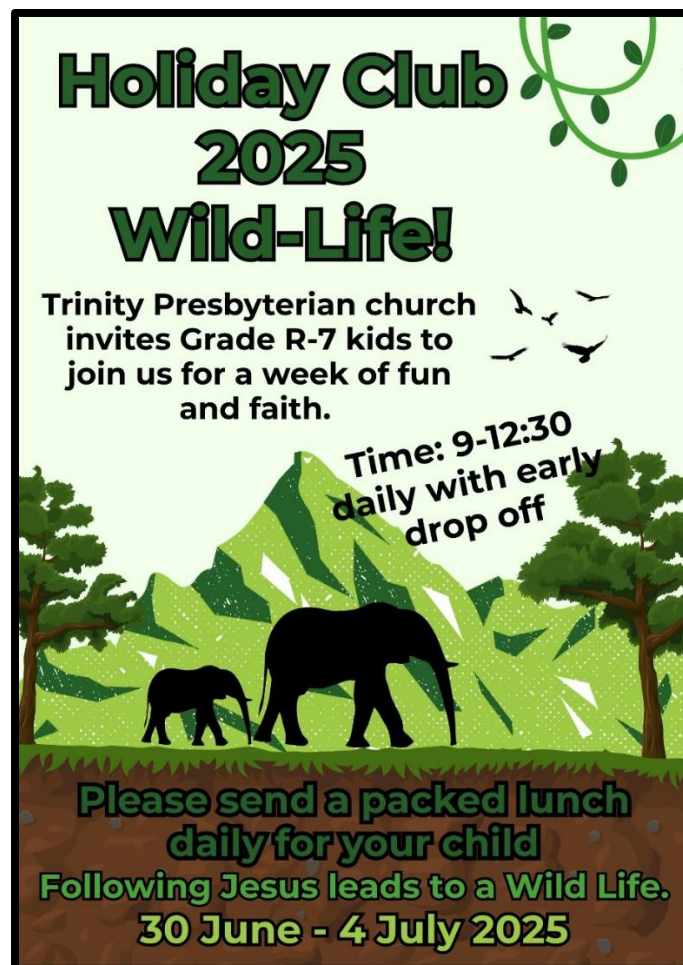

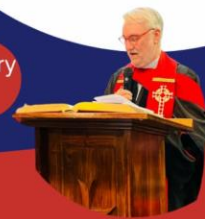
