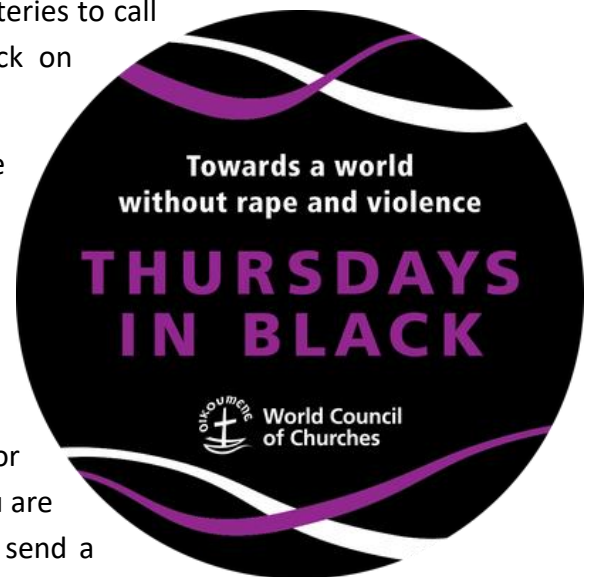
Dear Friends,

At the recent General Assembly, three of the reports (from the Ecumenical Relations Committee, Church in Society Committee and the Gender Desk) highlighted an initiative called "Thursdays in Black".

One of the proposals is "The General Assembly commends the programme, "Thursdays in Black," as a protest against Gender based violence and encourages Synods and Presbyteries to call Presbyterians to participate in this programme by wearing black on Thursday."

The report states, "Thursdays in Black is a silent protest against the epidemic of Gender Based violence perpetrated in our communities. It is also a sign of solidarity with the victims and a reminder that violence against one of us is violence against all."

One way to enhance the impact of the campaign is to wear a button badge which shows the purpose of wearing black and to start conversations. I have committed to wearing black on Thursdays for several months now. I commend this initiative to you as well. If you are interested in getting button badge, please reply to the email or send a WhatsApp to the church office.



I want to commend another initiative by the Edenvale pastors which will be taking place on heritage day in September (24th). It is called "the Street Store". It is a pop-up store which will enable people who struggle to afford the basic necessities to shop for a pair of clothes and shoes in a dignified way. To accomplish this initiative, we need clothes and we need volunteers. Currently, we have 75 volunteers and we need 100. There is an amount of R20 000 still needed to cover health and safety requirements for the day. 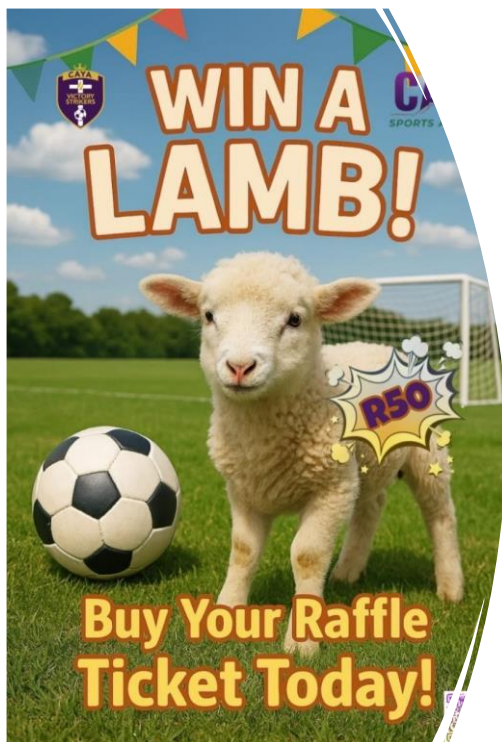

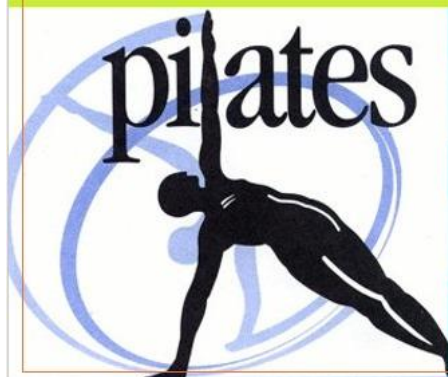
