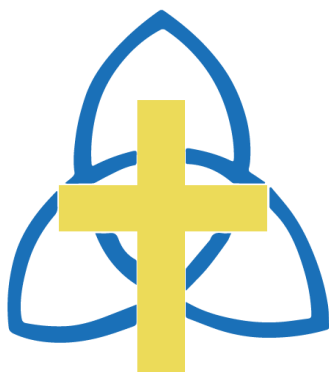

Dear Friends,

On Sunday, we took up a retiring offering for the Presbyterian Education Fund. This is a fund which aims to offer financial assistance to high school and tertiary learners who are members of the UPCSA. Currently, it does not have the capacity to offer complete bursaries. It assesses the needs of the applicant and decides how much the fund is able to contribute toward the fees.

We have a number of young people who have passed matric in our congregation who have the desire to study and work but who do not have the opportunity or the means to do so. We have had conversations in the Session meetings over the past two months about how we could address this need. We are still exploring ideas and having conversations. I want to invite you into the conversation.

Here are some of the things we are considering:

- Finding ways to support the young people through linking them up with people in the line of work which they are interested in. This could take the shape of a kind of mentorship or advice about avenues of entry or job shadowing. The relationship could offer prayer support and encouragement.
- Exploring avenues of resourcing and help with applying for financial assistance.
- Creating a space where young people have access to a computer and internet so that they can create a CV, apply for jobs/financial assistance, or learn online through free courses.

If any of these ideas have sparked something for you or if you have other ideas, please chat to Ross or me.

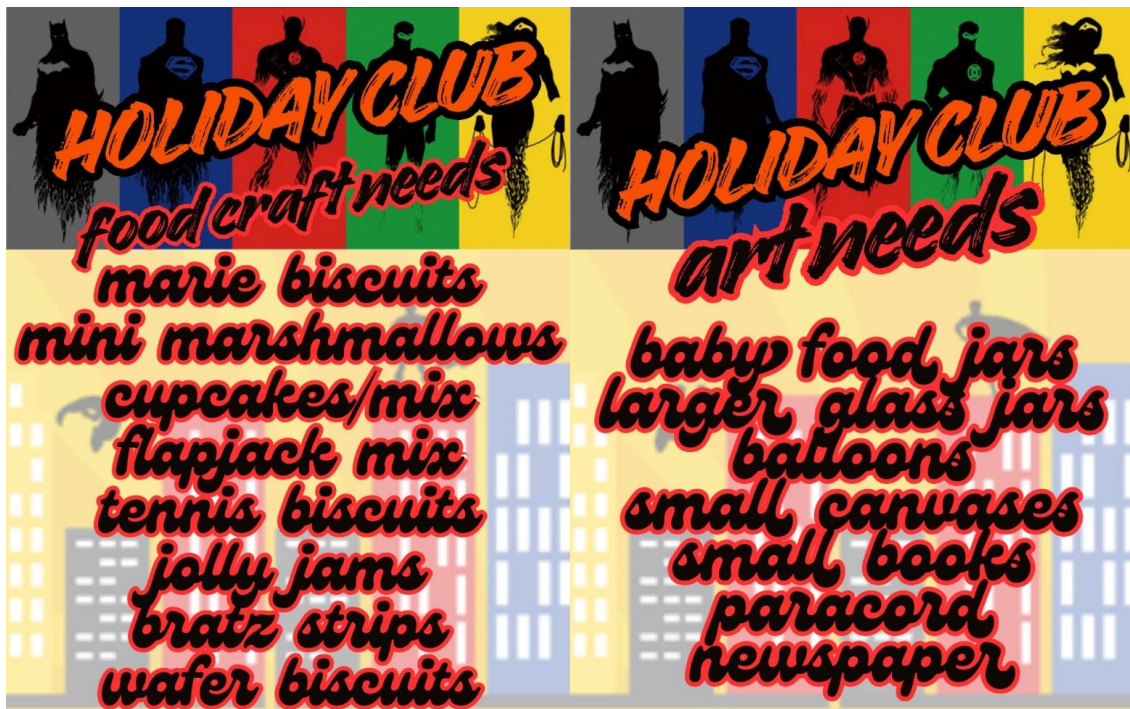
